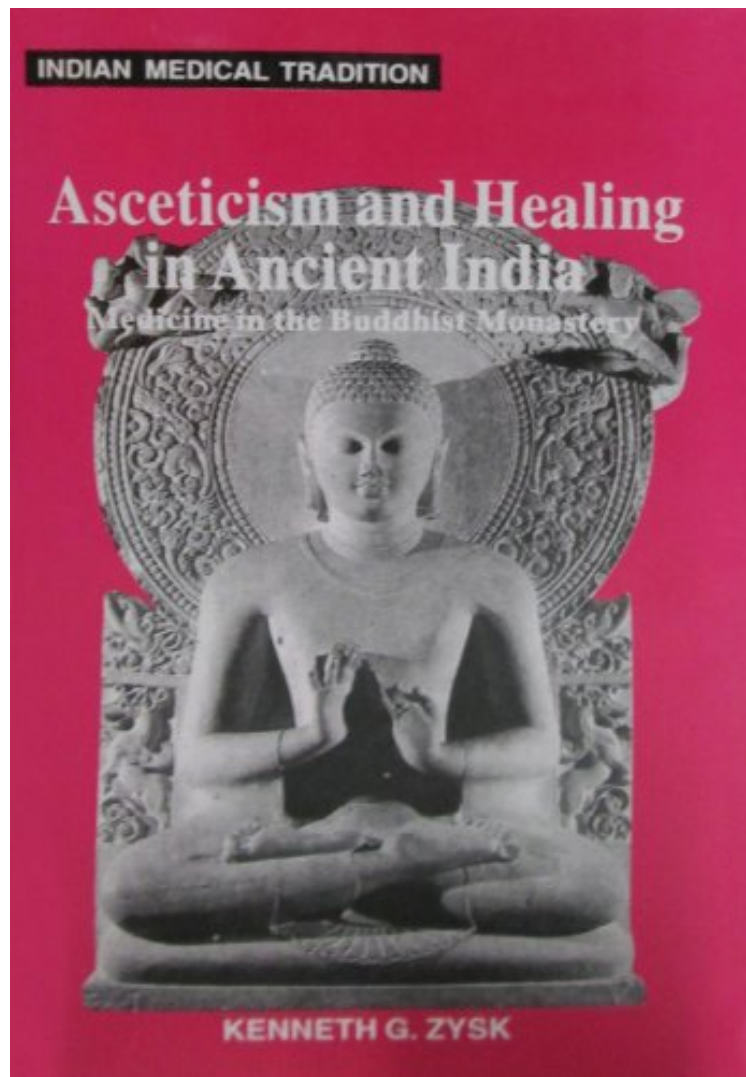

Drawing on a wide range of textual, archaeological, and secondary sources, Zysk first presents an overview of the history of Indian Medicine in its religious context. He then examines primary Literature from the Pali Buddhist Canon and from the Sanskrit treatises of Bhela, Caraka, and Susruta.
