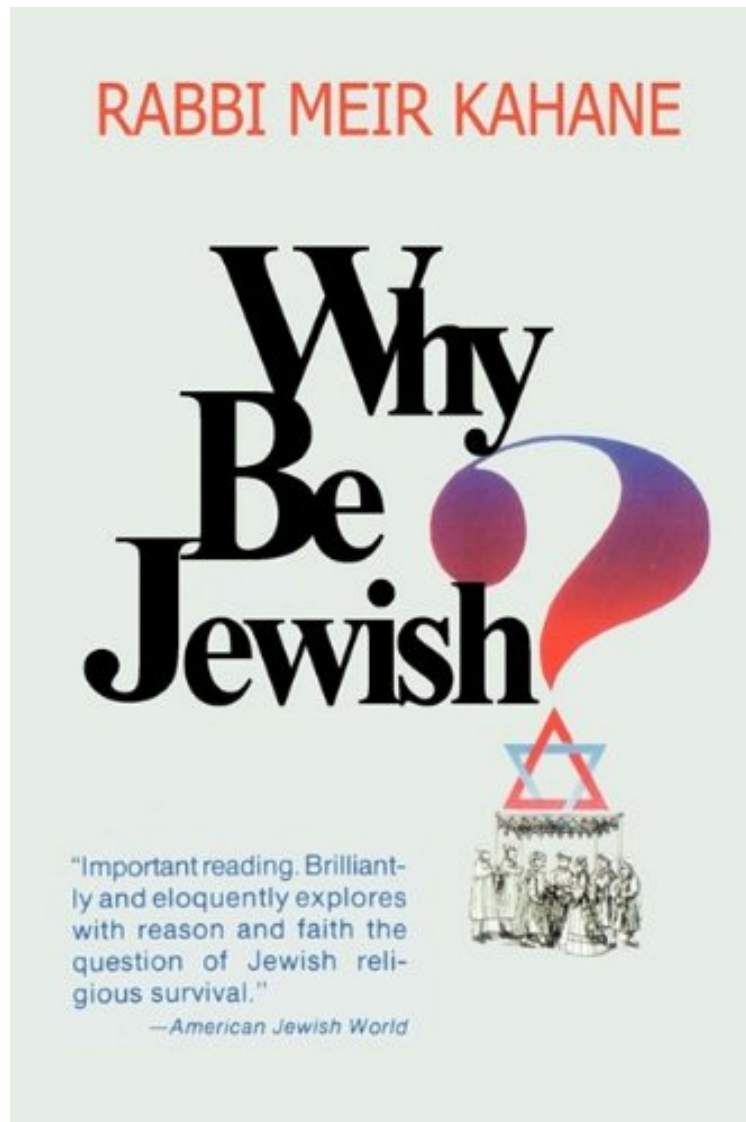

Much of this book is devoted to relating the unsavory history of the Jewish establishment - the Reform and Conservative movements, the Federations, and the alphabet soup of communal agencies which serve the glory of their donors, but often take Jewish observance and even Jewish survival too lightly. The innocent reader will be shocked to learn how the American Jewish establishment betrayed European Jewish refugees fleeing the Holocaust. The late Rabbi Kahane's prophecies were like a fire-bell in the night, deliberately disturbing the comfortably complacent American Jewish community.
