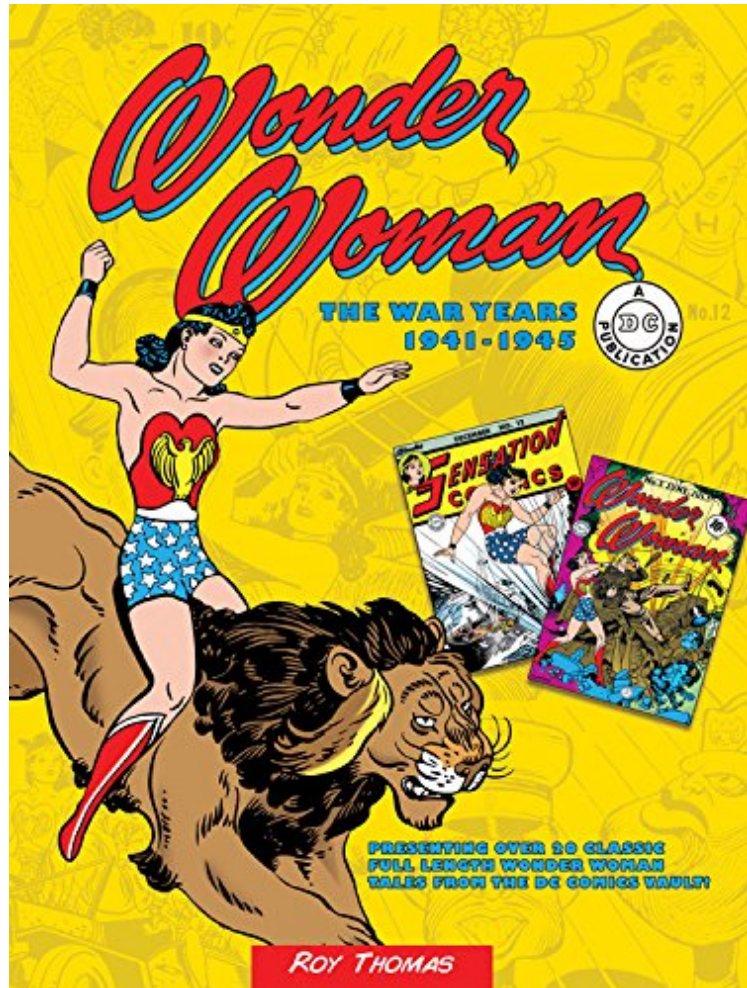

My review is for that title but it could be put in any of the other titles featuring Batman and Superman. I happen to be a big fan of golden age comics, I probably have most of these stories already but I liked the idea of having reasonably priced hardcover editions.My complaint is the way this is designed-- while the book is on the larger size the comics themselves are printed about 1/3 smaller than they could be and a border is placed all around the outside of each page to fill the dead area. Why wasn't this either printed at a different size or the art itself adjusted to fit the page? It's distracting and disappointing in an otherwise nice collection
