This is not your normal Gregorian calendar. This is an old Norse / Icelandic calendar for 2016 which has been integrated with the Gregorian calendar for easy understanding. The Old Norse calendar is in the forefront and the Gregorian in the background (to prevent you from missing that all important meeting). The calendar features the Old Norse seasons, months and periods. It features important Asatru dates such as blots, equinox festivals, lunars and solstices. It offers brief explanations of each month as well as each blot / celebration.

About the AuthorSigrun was born in Iceland around the summer solstice in 1970. At the age of 16 she became fascinated with Viking genealogy and at the age of 20, published a book where she had traced her ancestry back to Odinn himself. Having grown up with adventures from Norse mythology and tales of trolls, elves and hidden people, she is highly tuned with her heritage and the people and customs that she comes from. Sigrun showed very early signs of being a keen craftswoman and is constantly exploring new materials and methods for creativity.
